1. What is the Morningstar Investment Research Center?

The Morningstar Investment Research Center is a comprehensive financial database that provides independent ratings and analysis on a wide range of financial products. Up-to-date financial news and information, tools for analyzing your portfolio, and online investment courses and webinars are also available through the Morningstar database.

2. How do I access the site through the Mountain View Public Library?

Access Morningstar by going to <https://mountainview.gov/morningstar> and entering your MVPL card number.

Note: Keep the library name as “mountain view” (lower case), since this field is case sensitive.

3. How do I use the Investment Research Center?
